



AMENDMENT TO:
AUSR and/or OGF Permit for OIL & GAS WELLS

An amendment to an Administrative Use by Special Review (AUSR) Permit or OGF Permit must be obtained if proposed changes for an oil and gas facility also require an amendment to the COGCC Form 2A, per Section 4-10-02-03-07-10 of the Adams County Development Standards and Regulations. If staff consultation determines the proposed change requires a major amendment to the existing permit, all items below must be submitted. A major amendment permit application must meet all applicable requirements of an OGF Permit and be approved in writing by the Director or BOCC, if the BOCC approved the original application.

Primary Submittal Items

- Development (Universal) application
- Application fee of \$2,000
- Tri-County Health Department review fee of \$245
- Written Explanation of the Project
 - A detailed description of proposed changes, current permitted conditions, and impacts of proposed change(s) on site conditions and operations.
- Original and Amended COGCC Form 2A and Form 2
- Site Plan and Impact Area Map
 - See Section 2-02-14-05.3(c)
 - Amendments warranting alternative site analysis must first go through conceptual review process
- Neighborhood Meeting Summary
- Engineering Documents
 - Construction Plans
 - Grading Erosion and Sediment Control
 - Drainage study/technical drainage letter/plan (if applicable—see DSR ch. 9)



- Oil and Gas Operations Plan
 - See Section 2-02-14-05.3
 - Specifically highlight modifications and changes to operations plan

- Surface Owner Documentation
 - See Section 2-02-14-05.3(g) of the Development Standards & Regulations for more information.

- Updated Ambient Sound Study, as applicable

- Updated Emergency Preparedness Plan
 - See Section 4-10-02-03-03-03.8 of the Development Standards & Regulations for more information.
