

COVID-19 GRANT APPLICATION

American Rescue Plan Act Funding

Adams County is providing grants through the Adams County COVID-19 Grant Program to eligible nonprofit organizations, school districts, special districts, businesses, and nongovernmental organizations through an open, competitive grant application process. The grant program is funded by the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA).

Eligibility Requirements

FUNDS REQUESTED MUST BE USED IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19 ITSELF OR THE HARMFUL CONSEQUENCES OF THE ECONOMIC DISRUPTIONS RESULTING FROM OR EXACERBATED BY THE COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY.

To apply, organizations serving Adams County residents must meet these requirements:

- Must be in good standing concerning state and local taxes, any appropriate professional licensing and/or program (state and federal), and must be in compliance with any appropriate and applicable local codes and ordinances
- Must be in good standing with the Colorado Secretary of State
- Must have endured negative economic impact due to the COVID-19 public health emergency
- Must report any other governmental, private or charitable assistance received that supplanted any losses or offset revenue
- Any national, state, or local elected office holders with business interest will not be eligible

- Nonprofit organizations
- School districts
- Special districts
- Businesses
- Nongovernmental organizations

When to Apply

- November 1, 2021 Application period opens
- December 31, 2021 Applications due
- Early 2022—Grants awarded
