DISCUSSION POINTS:

- CDOT Executive Director Shoshana Lew and other key CDOT staff requested an opportunity to meet with the BoCC to kick-off the I-270 Environmental Assessment (EA)
- The EA is required be the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and must be completed prior to the commencement of any construction with federal funds
- CDOT anticipates an EA could be completed in 18 months, which is an aggressive timeline that is
 made possible based upon the extensive work that was been done in anticipation of this project
- CDOT will share its plans for stakeholder and public outreach for the I-270 EA project
- Adams County staff will continue to be very engaged in this effort in order to assist with making it a thorough, complete, and efficient EA process
- CDOT staff will also ask for input on the project at the Vasquez and 60th Ave. intersection, which is within the boundaries of Commerce City, but inherently connected to the I-270 EA project.



DISCUSSION POINTS:

- Adams County has been approached to contribute \$2 million toward an interchange improvement and road widening project along 64th Ave. in the Aerotropolis. The extent of the planned improvements is from the E-470 interchange at 64th Ave. to Jackson Gap, which is the south entrance to Denver International Airport (DEN)
- Representatives from Aurora Economic Development Council and E-470 will be in attendance to
 present project details, the project cost estimate, the breakdown of contributions from all
 partners, and anticipated economic development in this corridor

64th Avenue ARI Authority Site Plans




64TH AVE. INTERCHANGE TIMELINE




