RESOLUTION REAPPOINTING SCOTT LAWSON AS THE COUNTY VETERANS SERVICE  
OFFICER

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 28-5-801, the Adams County Board of County Commissioners is required to establish a County Veterans Service Office, appoint a County Veterans Service Officer, and to compensate such person with moneys from the general fund; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 28-5-801, the appointment shall be for a term of two years; and

WHEREAS, Scott Lawson has been employed as the County Veterans Service Officer under an employment contract; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to C.R.S. § 28-5-801, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that Scott Lawson meets the qualifications to continue to serve as the County Veterans Service Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to employ Mr. Lawson as a regular, full-time County employee, subject to the policies and benefits of Adams County and Mr. Lawson desires the same.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners, County of Adams, State of Colorado, that Scott Lawson is hereby reappointed to the position of County Veterans Service Officer and will continue in that position as a regular full-time employee of Adams County.

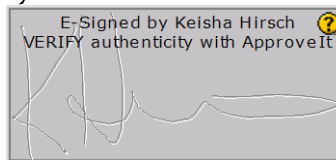
