FOR REPLACEMENT OF JACOBSEN EQUIPMENT FOR THE RIVERDALE GOLF

WHEREAS, On September 12, 2013, due to the excessive amount of rain the state received, the Riverdale Golf Course maintenance shop flooded, destroying a majority of the ground maintenance equipment; and,

WHEREAS, These particular pieces of equipment are unique to Jacobsen and C&M Golf and Grounds is the local dealer for Jacobsen Equipment; and,

WHEREAS, Adams County is able to piggy-back off cooperative awards through the National Joint Powers Alliance to purchase the equipment at a discount; and,

WHEREAS, The cooperative agreements fulfill the requirements of FEMA, the State of Colorado and the Adams County Purchasing Policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners, County of Adams, State of Colorado, that C&M Golf and Grounds Equipment be awarded a purchase order for the replacement of the Jacobsen grounds maintenance equipment in the amount of \$95,756.50.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Purchasing Division of the Finance Department is hereby authorized to sign the purchase order with C&M Golf and Grounds Equipment.
