**Sheriff's Office Launches MyPD Smartphone App**

The Adams County Sheriff's Office is excited to announce the launch of the "MyPD" smartphone app. The MyPD app allows citizens to download the app to their iPhone or Android and connect with the Sheriff's Office directly from their device. The Adams County Sheriff's Office is the first agency in Colorado to use the MyPD app.

The MyPD app allows users to have an open dialog with the Sheriff's Office through features such as a questions and feedback function. The app also provides users with a directory of contact information for different divisions within the Sheriff's Office, and a feature that will provide GPS directions to the Sheriff's Office.

One of the features of the app is the ability for users to submit tips to the Sheriff's Office about crimes and other quality of life issues. The users can choose to provide their personal information when they submit tips, or they can choose to remain anonymous. The app also allows users the option to provide photos and GPS locations of the incidents that they are reporting if they choose.

Additionally, the app also links to the Sheriff's Office social media sites, and several other resources that will be useful to our citizens. Some of those resources include crime maps, sex offender registries, jail information, and a local missing children database.

The MyPD app is free to download, and it contains no advertising. Users of the app are not required to set up an account or provide their personal information to use the app, but they may choose to provide the information if they wish.

Connecting with the Adams County Sheriff's Office is as easy as searching for "MyPD" in the app store, and downloading it. Once the app is downloaded and the user chooses the Adams County Sheriff's Office as their agency, the app will always open directly to the Adams County Sheriff's Office.

Sheriff Michael McIntosh says, "The Sheriff's Office will keep community first, and The MyPD app promotes community connection and awareness."
