Review of Financial Report shows grantee status as to date Lutheran Family Services and Project Angel Heart have spent 100%, Almost Home spent 70.43% and Growing Home, once they submit December 2017 invoice will have spent 100%. Side Note: Almost Home received an extension and was approved by the Adams County BOCC to spend money down. Project Angel Heart was given more funding and also received an extension approved by the Adams County BOCC.
