  - O A clarification is needed (Article III Sect. 2), the Executive Board has the ability to remove general assembly members who attend less than 50% of the annual meetings from the annual roster submitted to the CEPC. Colorado State Statute provides immunity protection for LEPC planning activities. To do so, an annual membership roster is submitted to the CEPC. The LEPC Executive Board has the ability to remove a general member from this due to a lack of participation. The Executive Board however does not have the ability to remove a sitting Executive Board member. That power rests with the Board of County Commissioners.

  - Answer: No. That is often the responsibility of Tri-County Health Department within Adams County.

# Pipeline Safety for Responders, Outreach, and Planning

- Pipeline identification
