

NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT HEARING

Suncor Energy (U.S.A.), Inc. - Commerce City Refinery - Plant 2 (East) - Adams County Title V Operating Permit Renewal (950PAD108)

SUBJECT:

The Colorado Air Quality Control Commission will hold a public hearing to elicit and record comments on the proposed renewal of the Title V Operating Permit for the Suncor Energy Commerce City Refinery Plant 2 (East Plant) located at 5800 Brighton Boulevard, Commerce City, Colorado.

HEARING SCHEDULE:

The Air Quality Control Commission hearing will be held virtually over Zoom, in accordance with guidance from the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, related to the COVID-19 pandemic. These meetings will be recorded.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Section 25-7-114.5(6)(b) of the Colorado Revised Statutes provides an opportunity for any interested person to provide comments on the sufficiency of the proposed operating permit and accompanying documents and whether the permit application should be approved or denied. Requests were received for this public comment hearing March 12-19, 2021 from the following: 350 Colorado, Adams County BOCC, Colorado Rising, Commerce City, Defend Our Future, Earthjustice, Environmental Defense Fund, Good Business Colorado, Moms Clean Air Force Colorado, and WildEarth Guardians.

Comments from the public are invited regarding the draft operating permit for the Suncor Energy Commerce City Refinery Plant 2 (East). Instructions for providing public comment are provided within this notice and must be followed so the comments may be properly received and recorded into the hearing record.

However, written comments will be accepted by the Commission up to the close of the public comment hearing.

The purpose of the public comment hearing is to solicit comments regarding the proposed operating permit and its supporting documents. Public comments on air quality issues not related to the draft Title V operating permit will not be accepted into the record.

PARTY STATUS:

This is not a rulemaking hearing and the Commission will not consider party status requests.
