eligible elector of the District. The form or letter must be filed no earlier than January 1 and no later than the sixty-		
seventh (67 <sup>th</sup> ) day before the date of the next regular special district election. The form is filed with the Designated Election Official, or if none has been designated, the presiding officer or the secretary of the District at the address
